HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 20

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MR. TED PARKER UPON BEING NAMED THE 2019 SWISHER SWEETS/SUNBELT AG EXPO SOUTHEASTERN FARMER OF THE YEAR FOR MISSISSIPPI.

- WHEREAS, Ted Parker of Seminary, Mississippi, has been named
- 5 the 2019 Swisher Sweets/Sunbelt Ag Expo Southeastern Farmer of the
- 6 Year for Mississippi, a true testament of his dedication to the
- 7 farming industry; and
- 8 WHEREAS, at the young age of 18, Mr. Parker borrowed money to
- 9 buy 20 yearlings, paid that money back, and bought 30 yearlings
- 10 the next year, and now, after 40 years as a farmer, his 30
- 11 yearlings have flourished into seven farms in six Mississippi
- 12 counties, along with grazing locations across the Southeast and in
- 13 the Midwest; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Parker weight gains cattle, purchasing
- 15 lightweight calves weighing between 250 and 500 pounds and growing
- 16 them to feedlot-quality, 700 to 800 pound heifers and steers, and
- 17 he credits his successful business sense to the time he spent
- 18 working as a runner on the floor of the Chicago Mercantile

- 19 Exchange in 1982, an experience that allowed him to learn the
- 20 ropes and helped him further his business; and
- 21 WHEREAS, after he returned home from Chicago, Mr. Parker
- 22 built his heard to 125 head, steadily growing his operation on
- 23 rented land before buying a 250-acre parcel located 12 miles north
- 24 of where he grew up, in Covington County, Mississippi, and now he
- 25 operates properties in Greene, Hinds, Covington, Lawrence, Pearl
- 26 River and Jones Counties, as well as buying stations in Covington
- 27 and Pearl River Counties; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Mr. Parker and his wife received this award not
- 29 only because of his success in the beef cattle industry, but also
- 30 because of their service in a variety of local and state
- 31 organizations, including the Mississippi Cattlemen's Association,
- 32 Mississippi Farm Bureau, Mississippi Beef Council and the National
- 33 Cattlemen's Beef Association; and
- 34 WHEREAS, in addition to their civic and community
- 35 engagements, the Parkers have always been considered successful
- 36 stocker producers by their colleagues in the industry, but it is
- 37 their dedication to the beef industry, their fervent desire to
- 38 help those in need and their selfless willingness to share their
- 39 vast knowledge of the beef industry with others that truly makes
- 40 them so deserving of the Farmer of the Year title; and
- WHEREAS, another key to his successful farming career has
- 42 been his strong support system, including his wonderful employees,
- 43 his son Gent, who is in charge of all the trucking and shipping of

- 44 cattle and helps manage the grow yard in Edwards, Mississippi; his
- 45 son Carl, who operates the cattle buying station and manages the
- 46 Seminary Farm; and his loving wife of 32 years, Janet, who
- 47 supported the family on just her income in the beginning stages of
- 48 the operation but has been the overseer of the business end of the
- 49 cattle operation for the last 20 years; and
- 50 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
- 51 and honor the accomplishments of and tremendous contributions made
- 52 to the agricultural industry and to the State of Mississippi by
- 53 individuals such as Mr. Ted Parker:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 55 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
- 56 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Mr. Ted Parker
- 57 upon being named the 2019 Swisher Sweets/Sunbelt Ag Expo
- 58 Southeastern Farmer of the Year for Mississippi and extend our
- 59 sincerest blessings for continued success in all of his future
- 60 endeavors.
