The Mississippi Farm Bureau Women's Outstanding Achievements and Recognition Awards program is designed to recognize County Farm Bureaus for outstanding program achievements, which involve leaders and members.

- Highlights of the County Farm Bureau Recognition Program:
- This will be a one (1) year program.
- The standard used to promote the program was developed by the MFBF Women's Leadership Committee.

Recognition & Awards Criteria:

In order to qualify, award books must be **EMAILED** by **October 15, 2023**. Please scan & email **ENTIRE AWARDS BOOK** with supporting documentation to <u>SWLC@msfb.org</u>.

No late entries will be accepted.

- An appreciation gift will only be given to those who turned in an award book by the deadline of October 15, 2023.
- The outstanding activity must be briefly described in no more than three hundred words and substantiated with no more than one picture and/or article per activity with the month and day of the activity.
- The Women's Achievement book should be approved and signed by the County Farm Bureau President and the County Women's Chair.
- No county will receive more than one Women's Achievement Award per year.
- A completed volunteer activity report must be submitted to the county secretary for each activity and report.
- One (1) county Farm Bureau from each of the eight (8) Women's Districts will be named district winner and receive a monetary award.
- There is a monetary award to the winning county in each of the four categories:
 - o Information, Organization, Governmental Relations & Social Media
 - Agriculture in the Classroom
 - Community Service
 - Youth & Safety
- Requirements to serve as AFBF voting delegate: Must be entered in County Board and Committees programs accessible through the Farm Bureau computer network as the County Farm Bureau Women's Chair or Vice-Chair for a minimum of one year. Must turn in the Awards Book. AFBF voting delegates cannot serve for two consecutive years.

Point System:

Each Outstanding Achievements and Recognition Awards Program will be judged based on the following point system:

•	Youth & Safety	180 points
٠	Agriculture in the Classroom	240 points
